A total of **75 students** from **BA, BSc, and BCom** attended the session.





Overall, the lecture was an enlightening and motivating session that expanded the knowledge of students about the government support available for budding entrepreneurs and startups in India.

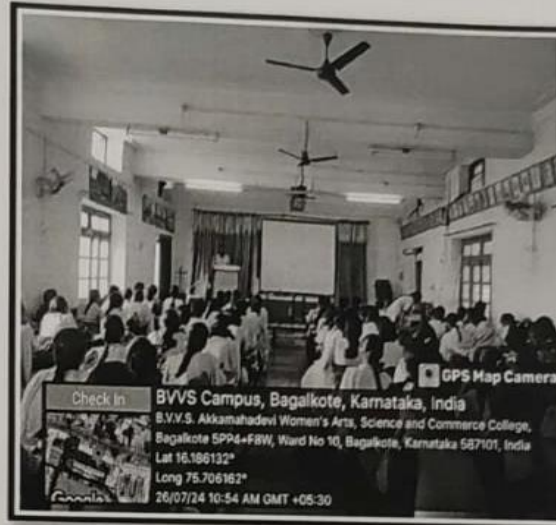

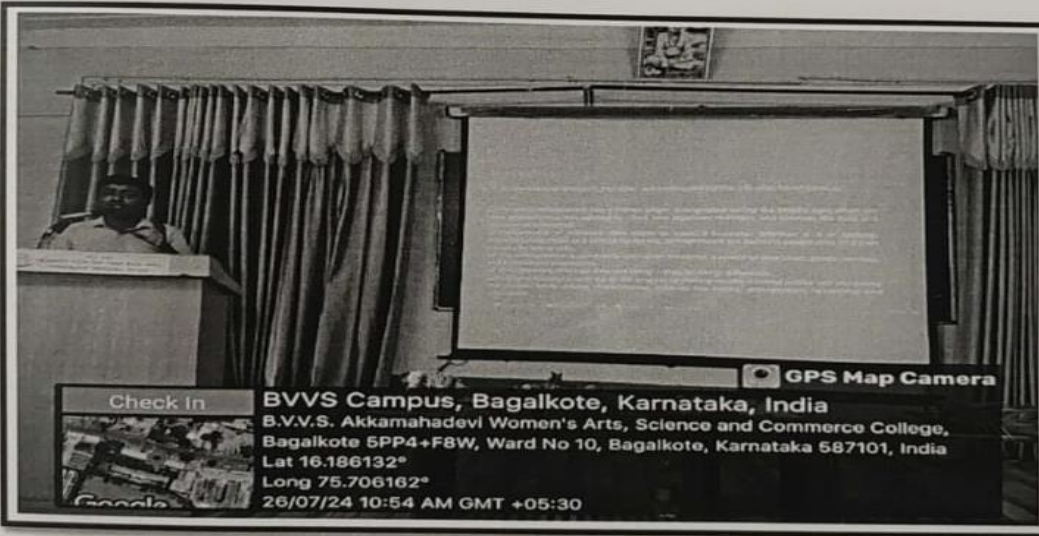
